

## THE WIM RECORD

1. Up till 31.10.2020, WIM has conducted 756 courses/events, benefitting 35,007 participants, a majority of which are free training courses for marginalised women in Small Businesses, Basic ICT, Domestic Violence and Prevention of HIV/AIDS.
2. WIM has produced several publications in Small Businesses, Reproductive Health, Real Estate Investment, Fundraising, a Finance Handbook in Bahasa Malaysia, English, Mandarin and Tamil, a Training Handbook on Prevention of HIV/AIDS and Domestic Violence in Bahasa Malaysia and English, The WIM Story, etc. WIM also produces an 80-page Business Journal, INSPIRE (3 issues per year) covering articles on Leadership, Education, Management, Law, Health, Entrepreneurship and Women's Issues. As at 30.9.2020, INSPIRE is at its 43<sup>rd</sup> issue.
3. WIM's CEO has been invited to speak at the JFK School of Government, Harvard University, USA, at a Business Seminar of the Asian Development Bank at Vancouver, Canada, a Women's Seminar organised by Judge Business School, Cambridge University, UK at Kuala Lumpur, a Conference of Government Women Officers organised by the Government of Western Australia at Perth, a Conference organised by the Asia-Australia Institute at Bali, several conferences of the Global Summit of Women, Washington, D.C., Seminar of the South East Asian Ministers of Education Organisation, Brunei among many others.

WIM has received many awards including Malaysian Power Brand for Education 2011 Award, Winner of the European Union- Malaysia Chamber of Trade and Commerce Sustainability Award 2012 in the Empowerment of Women category, the National Outstanding Educator Award (College category) by Koperasi Pendidikan Swasta, Malaysia Berhad in 2015, recognised by the Ministry of Women Development, Malaysia as "Juara Wanita", in 2015 and awarded "Best Businesswomen's Networking Organisation in South East Asia" by APAC Insider, UK in 2020

Throughout the years, WIM has received visits from many international VIP Women Leaders and organisations including a Queen Mother from South Africa, the First Lady of Zambia, the Crown Princess of Denmark, the wife of the United Nations Secretary-General, the Lady Mayoress of London, Deputy Prime Minister of Australia, women ministers from Mauritius and South Africa, delegation from the Commonwealth Parliamentary Organisation, UK, Women in Government (WIG) USA, government officials from Sri Lanka, Bangladesh and Mongolia, the Shell Diversity Dept. from Shell Co. Ltd, London.
6. WIM has received funding from the Malaysian Government (one time only), United Nations Population Fund, the OSK Foundation, the Royal Netherlands Embassy, Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA), many foundations, corporates and well wishers.
7. WIM co-organised an International Conference on Nation-Building with the Institute of Future Studies for Development, Thailand at Bangkok from 6-8<sup>th</sup> November 2018. At this Conference, WIM's CEO presented a paper on "Empowerment of Rural Women Leading Towards a Developed Country".
8. WIM has conducted a successful British MBA degree programme since year 2000, and currently applying to conduct an Executive Certificate Programme on Women's Leadership. In support of this new Programme, WIM had a successful Forum on "Women's Leadership Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow" on Hari Wanita on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2020. WIM has also created a Tan Sri Dato Napsiah Omar Chair on Women's Leadership.
