a) To assist 100 youths with favourable conditions to set up their own business and to become shareholders of MK Curtain before the year 2025, and to make themselves young millionaires.
b) To build MK Curtain to be an international brand with fashionable curtains, thereby making Negeri Sembilan, Malaysia well-known in the world.

2012

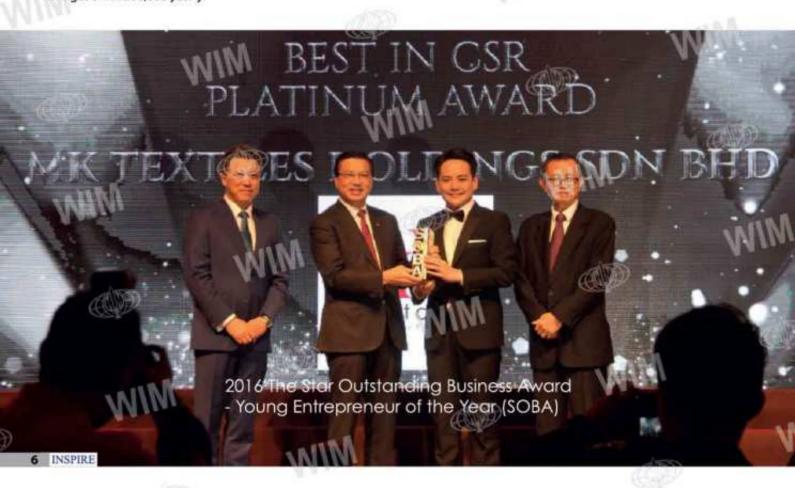

On His Story

Datuk Wira Calvin Khiu is a self-made entrepreneur, a maverick who went from attending a gas station to a factory worker and a salesman, before finally striking out on his own. In 2005, he started his first endeavour in the world of business with his first curtain store in Nilai 3, with just three employees and a vision for success. It was not an easy road. He faced bankruptcy not once, but twice, still, Datuk Calvin refused to give up. Instead, he developed his own management system, the "12 Steps of Outstanding Entrepreneurship" which would become the foundation of his success.

Using his own system, Datuk Calvin turned his business around and rose to the top of his industry, but he did not stop there. In 2016, after eleven years of entrepreneurship, he founded the OE EduGroup. This is a natural progression as he wants to share his knowledge and experience with the next generation of business leaders. What makes Datuk Calvin stand out from the pack is not just his business acumen. It's his unwavering commitment to excellence, his refusal to settle for anything less than outstanding.

Trials Which Nearly Broke His Back

The road to triumph has not been without its share of bumps and bruises for Datuk Calvin recalling his two most challenging crises which nearly made him caved. He was creating a rapid expansion by opening multiple branches which led to a breakdown in cash flow. He compressed that he did not know how to operate as a capitalist, or as a marketer. He did not manage his business accounts. He did not manage his personnel. The lack of financial knowledge and expertise left him in a vulnerable position and caused a significant setback in his business journey.

The above quotation tells us that "if you know who you are, you can dare to be different". However, it is sometimes very difficult to be different. Anyone who has tried to step out from the flock understands that to do so involves a measure of personal sacrifice which may cause criticism from others, self-doubt and isolation. All adventure achievers experience some degree of difficulty before they see their ultimate objective and step out from the crowd. But they overcame their frustrations and grew to achieve an independence that empowered them.





The second crisis came in the form of a real estate investment which nearly cost him his entire enterprise. A RM7 million ringgit factory purchase, fuelled by cash rather than careful planning, left him with frozen assets and insufficient funds to run his operation. "I didn't have enough money to buy goods, I didn't have enough money to pay the rent," he recounted. The capital chain was broken, and store closures were inevitable at that time.

He cautions that the hardships serve as a reminder that even the most successful individuals face challenges and setbacks. It is the ability to persevere and learn from mistakes that sets them apart. These crises taught Datuk Calvin the need for strategic planning and layout. These experiences taught him the importance of having a proper contingency plan when budget issues arise, especially for small and medium-sized enterprises.

OE EduGroup

With his experience as a pioneer in the curtains industry, facing problems, experiencing success, facing more problems and overcoming such problems, it was not surprising that Datuk Calvin Khiu next embarked into the Education and Training business, the DE EduGroup, which was founded by Datuk Khiu on 10th October 2016.

The 21st Century will be a time of unsettling change. We can meet its challenge with frustration and fear or with courage

and creativity. The choice is ours. But the answer oddly enough, is not an external one. As former British Prime Minister, Winston Churchill said: "The empires of the future are the empires of the mind."

The epidemic is raging in 2020 and the Education field was faced with several challenges of not being able to open classes. However, OE EduGroup decided to go against the current, making good use of the power of network technology to achieve a number of records in Malaysia, creating a single product in a day. With a turnover of 2 million, the performance has grown by 100%.

OE not only broke records by itself, but also led their student to reform and innovate. In 2 years, Datuk Calvin Khiu guided his elite students to break more than 200 records in the Malaysia Book of Records. During the 2021 pandemic, OE even won the "Guinness World Records" leadership course with the most participants.

In just 4 years, OE EduGroup gathered students from all over the world, i.e. Singapore, Indonesia, Philippines, Australia, China, Thailand and the United Kingdom. These students include professionals, government officials, entrepreneurs, listed companies, company bosses, and thousands of other groups.

From only 20 students in its first course, the OE EduGroup has now more than i million online and offline students around the world. OE EduGroup is a new type of education company which combines technology with entrepreneurs. This new education enterprise is omnipresent and seamless, allowing students to learn anytime and anywhere, to the convenience of students: coaching entrepreneurs, training and assisting them to upgrade and transform with new models, and helping entrepreneurs to change the fate of small and medium sized entrepreneurs. In 2020, due to the impact of the epidemic, the education field faced several challenges of not being able to start classes.

Today, OE is still going against the current, using the power of network technology to transfer students from offline to online, and thereafter, break a number of records in Malaysia, i.e. 27,000 people watched the course at the same time and 5,000 people signed up for the course, ultimately creating a turnover of nearly 2 million sales for a single product in one day, successfully increasing the sales by 160%. In the next 3 years, OE EduGroup plans to enter Southeast Asian countries such as Indonesia, Brunei, and Singapore, attach importance to technology transactions, and use Southeast Asia as a springboard to enter Asia and the world.

Even during the challenging times of the 2021 epidemic, OE EduGroup won the Guinness World Records – the leadership course with the most participation. OE EduGroup's "12 Steps of New Outstanding Entrepreneurship" is not only in the Chinese market, but also opens up the English and Malay markets. At present, there are 5 education brands in different education fields and 19 practical speakers in different industries to provide students with the most practical knowledge.
